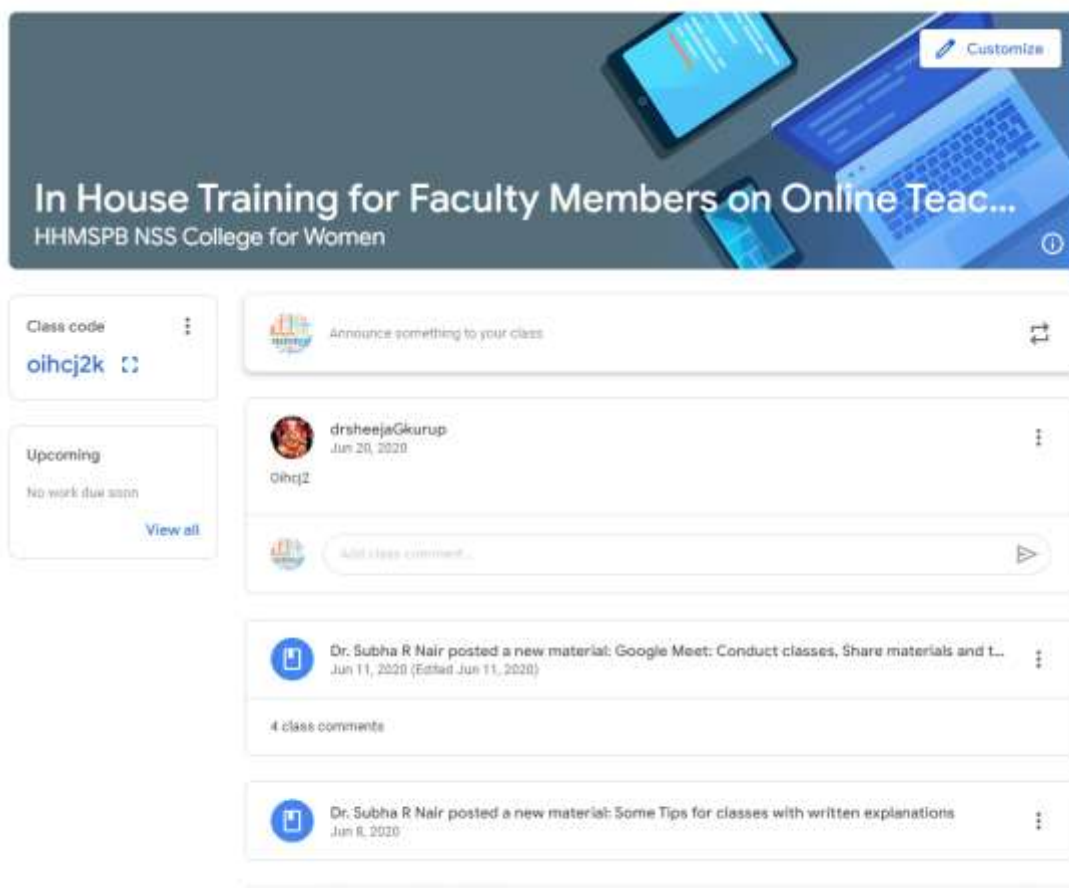

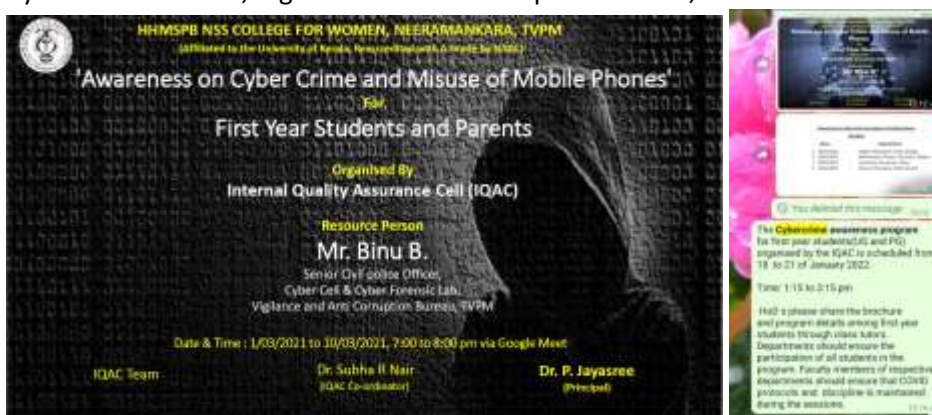
IQAC International Webinar Series incorporating every department for motivating the student community into active research by familiarizing them with the global academia



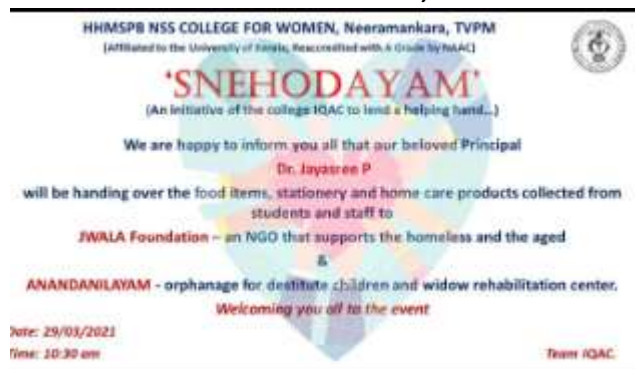


## 6. 'AWARENESS ON CYBERCRIME AND MISUSE OF MOBILE PHONE':

The COVID -19 lockdown created a situation where students are continuously exposed to the world of the internet. In such a scenario, it is rudimentary to provide awareness to the students as well as parents on the threats and dangers of the syber world. Keeping this in mind , the IQAC organised a series of Webinars on 'Awareness on Cyber Crime and Misuse of Mobile Phones' was conducted for the first year students and their parents of every department. The resource person was Mr. Binu B, Senior Civil Police Officer, Cyber Cell and Cyber Forensics Lab, Vigilance and Anticorruption Bureau, Trivandrum.



## 7. 'SNEHODAYAM' : SOCIAL SERVICE, CHARITY AND EXTENSION ACTIVITY INITIATIVE OF IQAC



The college IQAC conducted a charitable drive named “SNEHODAYAM” on 29-03-2021. An initiative of IQAC, to uphold the social responsibility of our college SNEHODAYAM – charitable drive was undertaken with the whole participation of the students and teachers of the institution. The stakeholders were selected based on a survey conducted in Thiruvananthapuram city. As part of ensuring the social responsibility of our institution, two stakeholders were identified as *Jwala* foundation – a charitable organisation and *Anandanilayam* – an orphanage in Thiruvananthapuram city.

The main objective of the programme aimed to distribute the necessary food items (rice, grams, groceries etc) for the *Jwala* foundation and to supply sanitary materials

to the inmates of *Anandanilayam*. *Jwala* foundation is a charitable organisation founded by Ms Aswathy Jwala. The main activities are supplying daily meals to the homeless people in the city and its outskirts. Due to the outbreak of pandemic, they faced challenges in the availability of sufficient funds to mobilise the resources. Hence, the routine programme of this foundation was slowed down. IQAC identified the problem and planned to collect the raw food items from the students and staff of our college.

The orphanage *Anandanilayam* is having inmates belonging to various age groups (students and old aged people also). The second charitable activity undertaken with the initiative of IQAC was to provide sanitary and study materials to the inmates of the orphanage.
